



## EMPLOYEE DRESS CODE

UDST's dress code is modest business dress. As an employee, you are required to exercise good discretion to ensure that you maintain a professional appearance while at work. It is also important to show respect to the local culture, religious values, and traditions.

### Men's Clothing & Footwear Do's:

- Do cover the knees and shoulders.
- Do wear long sleeve shirts with a collar and a tie.
- Do wear full-length dress pants.
- Do wear a jacket if you are expecting to meet guests or attend an external meeting outside of the University.
- Do wear subdued colours.
- Do wear a national dress.
- Do wear closed shoes and socks.
- Do cover tattoos while on campus.
- Do wear sandals if worn with the national dress.
- Exceptions apply to footwear worn should this be required for medical reasons.



### Men's Clothing & Footwear Don'ts:

- Do not wear short sleeve shirts.
- Do not wear short sleeve T-shirts.
- Do not wear shorts.
- Do not wear denim.
- Do not wear earrings while on campus.
- Do not wear hats, (unless they are professional and worn outside).
- Do not wear casual footwear such as flip-flops, slippers, etc.



## Women's Clothing & Footwear Do's:

- Do cover the knees and shoulders.
- Do wear blouses that fully cover the torso with sleeves ending below or near the elbow.
- Do wear long dress pants at least three-quarter length.
- Do wear skirts or dresses that are below the knee, even while sitting, If tights are worn, they must be worn with skirts or dresses below the knee.
- Do cover tattoos while on campus.
- Do wear a national dress.
- Do wear well-fitted comfortable shoes.
- Exceptions apply to footwear worn should this be required for medical reasons.



## Women's Clothing & Footwear Don'ts:

- Do not wear see-through materials and tight clothing.
- Do not wear casual capris or walking shorts.
- Do not wear low cut or midriff exposed clothing.
- Do not wear tights or form-fitting clothing such as leggings (unless professional and worn with skirts or dresses below the knee).
- Do not wear short sleeve shirts.
- Do not wear skirts above the knee.
- Do not wear denim.
- Do not wear hats (unless they are professional and worn outside).
- Do not wear casual footwear such as flip-flops, slippers, etc.



## Dress Code: Safety & other guidelines:

Please note that some business units may be exempt from some of these guidelines where there are specific safety and/or operational requirements (i.e. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)) in their work area. Please direct any questions to your Dean or Manager in that regard. Examples include but are not limited to:

- Lab coats in laboratories (Health Sciences).
- Approved uniforms, scrubs, etc. where required (i.e. Health Sciences, maintenance, catering, cleaning staff, etc.).
- Fitness clothing for Sport and Wellness employees.
